And he'll always be MY DAD

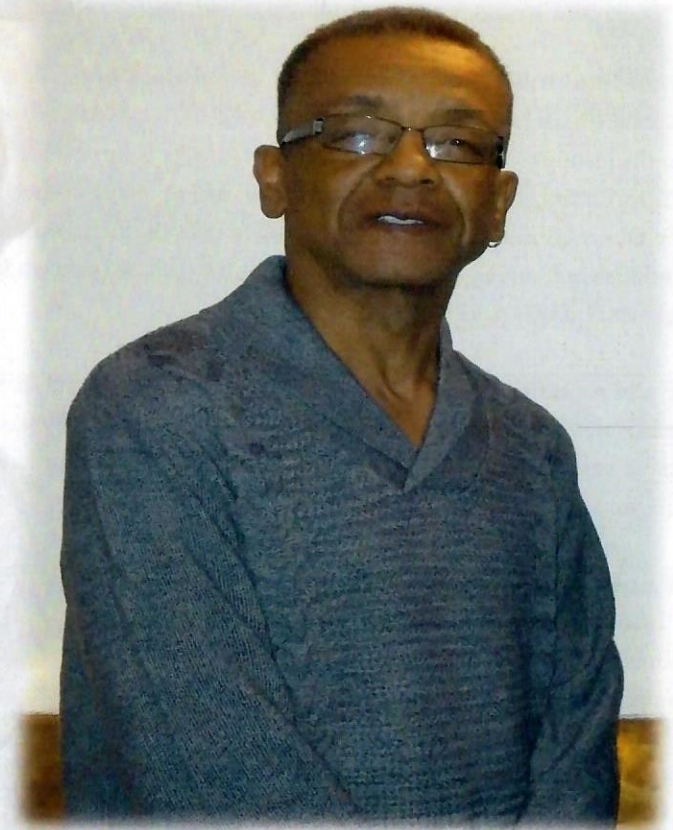
